ORDERS

Thoubal, the 19th January, 2017.

No. DC(TBL)/9/13/93/Arms(Misc)/2012 : Whereas, after the announcement of Poll Schedule for the General Elections to the 11th Manipur Legislative Assembly, 2017 by the Election Commission of India vide its Press Note No.ECI/PN/2/2017 dated 04/01/2017, the prevailing law & order situation in Thoubal District has been reviewed and examined minutely especially in view of the General Elections to the 11th Manipur Legislative Assembly, 2017 and the undersigned in my capacity as the District Magistrate of the District in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 21(1) of the Arms Act, 1959, was passed an order thereby directing the licensed holders of arms to deposit their licensed arms at the nearest concerned police stations on or before 11/01/2017, failing which their licensed arms & ammunitions will be confiscated by the District Police Administration, Thoubal District to ensure that no untoward/ unwanted incidents occur during the conduct of the General Elections to the 11th Manipur Legislative Assembly, 2017 vide this office order of even No. dated 06/01/2017;

And whereas, applications has been received from the license holders for retaining their licensed arms and all the applications has been considered by the Screening Committee constituted in this regard vide order of even No. dated 26/12/2016 and after consideration, the committee has recommended the following license holders (ANNEXURE-A) for accepting their request for exemption from the Order dated 06/01/2017 and they may allow to retain their arms for their self protection. If anything is happened with their arms involving crime, the arms license shall be cancelled forthwith. Appropriate action shall be taken up as per relevant provisions of Arms Act, 1959 and Arms Rules, 2016.
