No.20/26/ELEC/DC (DEO)/TBL/LS/2014/⁸³ In view of the General Elections to the 16th Lok Sabha-2014, it is hereby notified for information of all concerned more particularly the intending Candidates of No.-II-Outer Manipur (ST) Parliamentary Constituency [OM(ST)PC] that the following points/instructions, as per the Handbook for Returning Officer (2014 Edition) of ECI, New Delhi, should be noted carefully/complied with while the intending Candidates come for filing of nomination papers, for which the Public Notice is being issued by the Returning Officer (RO), No.-II-Outer Manipur (ST) Parliamentary Constituency on 15-03-2014:-

- i) *A maximum of four nomination papers only can be presented by or on behalf of any Candidate & these can be filed either together or separately.*
- ii) *The maximum number of vehicles accompanying the intending Candidate which will be allowed to come within a periphery of 100 meters of RO/ARO Office is restricted to 3(three) only and the maximum number of persons allowed to enter the office of RO/ARO at the time of filing nomination papers is limited to 5(five) including the Candidate.*
- iii) *Candidates are required to file only one affidavit in the revised Form 26 and no affidavit with blank particulars will be entertained. No column of the affidavit should be left blank or filled by just tick/dash marking. If the information sought for is nil or not applicable, he/she should write "Nil" or "Not applicable" or "Not known". Incomplete affidavits are liable to be rejected leading to rejection of nomination papers at the time of scrutiny.*
- iv) *For facilitating monitoring of election expenditure, each Candidate is required to open a separate Bank Account exclusively for the purpose of election expenditure and this Bank Account shall be opened at least one day before the date on which the candidate files his/her nomination papers and this account can be opened anywhere in the State. This Bank Account Number should be communicated to the RO by the Candidate in writing at the time of filing nomination papers.*
- v) *A sum of Rs.12,500/- should be deposited as the security deposit by the Candidate (ST) either in cash or through a Government Treasury through Challan.*
- vi) *Candidates set up by recognized National or State Parties are required to subscribe by only one elector of the Constituency as proposer, whereas the nomination of other Candidates are to be subscribed by ten electors of the Constituency as proposers.*
- vii) *The prescribed oath of affirmation making the oath before the authorized person should be submitted before the date fixed by the ECI for scrutiny of nomination papers.*
