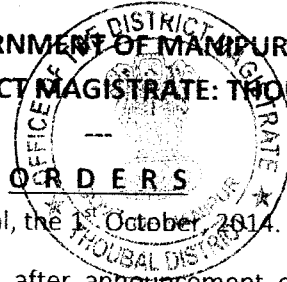


PROHIBITORY ORDERS

GOVERNMENT OF MANIPUR

No.4/65/DC(TBL)/2009/L&O/Pt.III Whereas, after announcement of election schedule to the Manipur Legislative Assembly Bye-Election to 38-Hiyanglam A/C by the Election Commission of India vide its Notification No. 100/MR-LA/1/2014 dated 20th September, 2014 the prevailing law and order situation in Thoubal District has been reviewed and examined minutely especially in view of the current Bye- election 2014 and the undersigned in my capacity as the District Magistrate of the District is fully convinced and satisfied that there are sufficient reasons/grounds for passing a prohibitory Orders under Sub-Section 2 of Section 144 of Cr.P.C. ,1973 to ensure that no untoward/unwanted incidents occur during the conduct of the current Bye- Elections 2014.

2. Whereas, the existing instructions/guidelines of the Election Commission of India more particularly the Para 3.6 of the Compendium of Instructions (Volume-I) of ECI regarding ban on carrying of licensed arms have also been examined, wherein it is directed that Prohibitory Orders under Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 should be issued banning the carrying of licensed arms as soon as the election is announced and the should be effective till the declaration of results.

3. However, in view of the current Bye- Election 2014 and as per directions of the ECI, there is an urgent need to issue/reissue a Prohibitory Orders.

4. Whereas, it has become expedient to issue prohibitory orders for prevention of breach of peace, disturbance to public to public tranquility and danger to human lives and loss of properties and to prevent any kind of riot or affray in the District more particularly in view of the current Bye- Election 2014.

5. Whereas, the emergent nature of the case and circumstance do not permit serving of notice upon the general public in due time and hence this order is passed ex-parte under Sub- Section 2 of Section 144.Cr.P.C and is directed to the public in general.

6. Now, therefore, I, Shri Ksh.Lemba Singh, MCS, District Magistrate, Thoubal in view of the volatile atmosphere prevailing in Thoubal District, the specific directions of the ECI as stated above and in view of the likelihood of occurrence of violence, breach of peace and untoward / unwanted incidents during the conduct of current Bye- Election 2014,in view of the likelihood occurrence of violence and breach of peace during the observance of ensuing Durga Puja festival commencing from 30/9/2014 and in exercise of powers conferred under Sub-Section 2 of Section 144 Cr.P.C. do hereby prohibit assembly of 5(five) or more persons which are likely to turn unlawful in the areas which are describe in the Schedule given below and also prohibit/ban carrying of the licensed arm, sticks ,stones, firearms, weapon and other explosive materials i.e. fire crackers, bam bulla etc. with immediate effect and until further orders. The orders shall take effect from 10.00 a.m. of 1st October, 2014.

7. This order shall not apply to agencies/ officials the Government involved in the enforcement of law and order and the maintenance of essential services.

8. Persons who want to take out procession for marriage, funeral and religious purposes etc. within the Scheduled areas may apply to the undersigned for permission and they shall not take out any kind of procession etc. until and unless the permission is obtained in this regard.

9. Copies of the this order be pasted on the notice boards of the District Magistrate, Thoubal, Superintendent of Police/Thoubal, ADM/Thoubal, SDOs/SDMs/AROs of Thoubal District and copies may also be sent to the DIPR, Manipur, DDK/Imphal and ISTV, Imphal for causing wide publicity.
