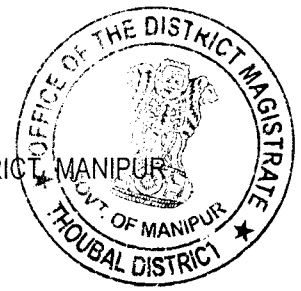

O R D E R S

No. DC(TBL)/9/13/93/Arms(Misc)/2012²⁰²⁹: Whereas, after the announcement of Bye-Election from 38- Hiyanglam Assembly Constituency of Thoubal District, Manipur by the Election Commission of India vide its Notification No. 100/MR-LA/1/2014 dated 20th September, 2014, the prevailing law & order situation in the Assembly Constituency has been reviewed and examined minutely especial in view of the ensuing Bye-Election from 38- Hiyanglam Assembly Constituency and the undersigned in my capacity as the District Magistrate of the District is fully convinced and satisfied that there are sufficient reasons / grounds for passing an appropriate order thereby directing the licensed holders of arms to deposit their licensed arms at the nearest police stations to ensure that no untoward/ unwanted incidents occur during the conduct of Bye-Election, 2014;

Whereas, it is considered necessary to withdraw all the licensed arms in the jurisdiction of 38-Hiyanglam Assembly Constituency and keep in the safe custody of such Police Stations having the jurisdiction where the residence of a licensee is located in view of the ensuing Bye-Election, 2014;

Now, therefore, I, Shri Ksh. Lemba Singh, District Magistrate, Thoubal in exercise of the powers conferred under Arms Act, 1959, do hereby order that all such licensees of 38-Hiyanglam Assembly Constituency shall deposit their licensed arms to the concerned nearest Police Stations with immediate effect and until further order and also prohibit / ban carrying of licensed arms by individuals who are coming from outside the areas of 38- Hiyanglam Assembly Constituency with a view to maintain law & order and to ensure peaceful conduct of Bye-Election, 2014.

Any individual who desires to appeal against this order may submit his/her written justification for retaining his/her licensed arms to the undersigned at the Deputy Commissioner's Office, Thoubal within office hours on or before 23-9-2014.
