

“India Disaster Resource Network” (IDRN) is a web based platform, provided by NIDM for managing the inventory of equipment, skilled human resources, critical supplies for emergency response at District/State/National levels (both private and public). These inventories can be of immense value in handling rescue and relief operations during and after disaster. During a recent interaction with NIDM, it was observed that the response from different users in the States and Districts in using and updating IDRN is not very encouraging. It is requested that different Departments concerned may be requested to upload requisite information on IDRN at the earliest.

2. It is also pointed out that even though NIDM is conducting various training courses on DM related matters at Central/State levels, the level of participation from States, particularly in the subject specific fields i.e. earthquake, drought, floods, tsunami etc. is not encouraging. This may be looked into and necessary direction/instructions issued to concerned Departments to send suitable personnel to NIDM to attend the specialized training courses. Also, wherever necessary, their feedback on such training may be sent to NDMA for further improvement.

3. The issue related to the non-utilization of trained personnel in States also needs to be addressed. The data base uploaded by NIDM on www.nidm.gov.in under the heading “Training & Workshops” may be utilized optimally, not only to train the other untrained personnel/staff who have not attended any direct training from NIDM at all, but also to use such expertise during actual disasters. This will lead to capacity building at grass root level which can be utilized in combating disasters.
